

Virgin Australia (VA) returns to Doha (DOH) in partnership with Qatar Airways (QR)

Agency Partners Fact Sheet

About the Virgin Australia (VA) flights to Doha operated by Qatar Airways (QR):

Virgin Australia is excited to announce that we have strengthened our strategic partnership with Qatar Airways. Subject to regulatory approval, Virgin Australia will offer daily services to Doha from Sydney, Brisbane, and Perth for sale from today, with flights commencing in June 2025. Flights from Melbourne will go on sale in early 2025, for travel from the end of 2025.

The new services will be operated by Qatar Airways for Virgin Australia. This partnership will provide greater choice, benefits and value for your customers including:

- More options for international travel, with an initial 21 additional flights to Doha from Sydney, Brisbane, and Perth. This expansion will increase to 28 weekly flights with the launch of the Melbourne to Doha route later in 2025. Subject to regulatory approval and availability.
- A seamless booking experience via Virgin Australia or Qatar Airways when arranging travel to Europe, Africa, the Middle East, and beyond.
- Great value fares on Virgin Australia flights to Doha, Qatar, flown on Qatar's Boeing 777, including the much loved QSuite, access to thousands of inflight entertainment options, and food and beverage.

Virgin Australia marketed international long haul flights operated by Qatar Airways for Virgin Australia (with VA flight numbers VA1 to VA29) will be available to sell from today, 12 December 2024, for travel from mid-June 2025, leaving from Sydney, Brisbane and Perth.

When will the tickets go on sale for the new services, and when will flying commence?

From 12 December 2024, Australians can book direct flights from Sydney, Brisbane, and Perth to Doha on 21 new weekly return Virgin Australia services (operated by Qatar Airways).

Subject to regulatory approval, the first services are expected to commence flying from:

- Departing Sydney: 12 June 2025
- Departing Brisbane: 19 June 2025
- Departing Perth: 26 June 2025

Melbourne to Doha route will launch later in 2025, at which point there will be 28 weekly return Virgin Australia services (operated by Qatar Airways).

What are the routes and schedule for this service?

Subject to regulatory approval, Virgin Australia will offer daily flights from Sydney, Brisbane and Perth from mid-June 2025, and Melbourne late-2025.

How can I purchase a fare on the new services through VA?

Virgin Australia marketed international long haul flights to Doha (operated by Qatar Airways) will be available for sale through the Australian point of sale and point of origin through VA and QR Sales channels. For all other points of sale, pricing will be made available globally through Qatar Airways sales channels only.

Will I be able to combine a VA marketed international long haul flight (with VA flight number VA1 to VA29) with another QR operated service on a single ticket?

For ticket combinability, please refer to the published fare rules.

Can a customer bring additional baggage on these new services?

No. Additional carry-on or checked baggage entitlements for Velocity Silver, Gold and Platinum members are not available on these services at this time. Can a customer pre-purchase additional baggage on these new services?

No. Any additional baggage on top of the included fare allowance can only be added as excess baggage at the airport, subject to space availability and on payment of a fee. What lounges will my customers who are travelling in Business Class have access to in Doha when travelling on the new VA services?

Eligible Business Class passengers will have access to the Al Mourjan Business Lounge in Doha. More information about lounge eligibility is available on the [Virgin Australia website](#).

What lounges do my customers have access to if they are Velocity Gold or Platinum members?

International lounge access to Qatar Airways owned and operated lounges and third-party partner lounges are available when travelling on a QR operated flight. This includes Virgin Australia marketed international long haul flights between Australia and Doha (operated by Qatar Airways) with a VA or QR flight number.

Eligible Velocity tier members can enjoy access to international lounges including:

*Velocity Member [Terms and Conditions](#) and Privilege Club Member [Terms and Conditions](#) apply. Velocity Points can be earned on Virgin Australia flights between Australia and Doha (operated by Qatar Airways for Virgin Australia) with a VA flight number VA1 to VA29 (inclusive). The Velocity Points earned will be calculated using the 'fare type originally purchased, and the miles flown as part of the Virgin Australia flight' method at the rates outlined on the table on the Virgin Australia partner page on the Velocity Frequent Flyer website. Velocity members will earn Status Credits on eligible Virgin Australia marketed flights with a VA flight number that are operated by partner airlines, Virgin Australia flights between Australia and Doha (operated by Qatar Airways for Virgin Australia) with a VA flight number VA1 to VA29 (inclusive). Status Credit earn for these flights is based on the fare type originally purchased and number of miles flown at the earn rates outlined on the relevant partner airline page on the Velocity Frequent Flyer website. For all Status Credit earn, Status Credits accrual is based on single flight segments that consist of individual flight numbers. An itinerary that involves a change in aircraft but retains the same flight number is considered a single flight segment. An itinerary that consists of a change in flight numbers, even if the same aircraft is used for the entire itinerary, is considered two flight segments. Domestic flights booked within an international journey will accrue Status Credits at the earn level for international flights. Members travelling on upgraded fares purchased with Points or any other subsidised means of upgrades on Virgin Australia or our partner airlines will earn Status Credits based on original purchased fare type.

*International lounge access to Qatar Airways owned and operated lounges and third-party lounges are available when travelling in Business class or guests who are a Velocity Gold and Platinum status members when travelling on a QR operated flight. This includes Virgin Australia flights operated by Qatar Airways with a VA-flight number between Australia and Doha.
